Assuming his traditional role as a griot within a non-traditional context, Abdoulaye Diabate sings a narrative that interweaves aspects of the different band members' lives. Singing in the traditional Malian language of Wolof, he reflects on the musicians' individual characteristics as they take turns improvising over an ever-unfolding tapestry which draws upon each player's musical background. As the piece evolves, he tells of how their lives came to intersect with one another and of their particular roles in the musical family that is Hieroglyphics, an ensemble that has endured in one form or another for more than 30 years. Aural Histories received it's premiere performances at Le Poisson Rouge in New York, Earshot Jazz Festival in Seattle and SF Jazz in San Francisco.
